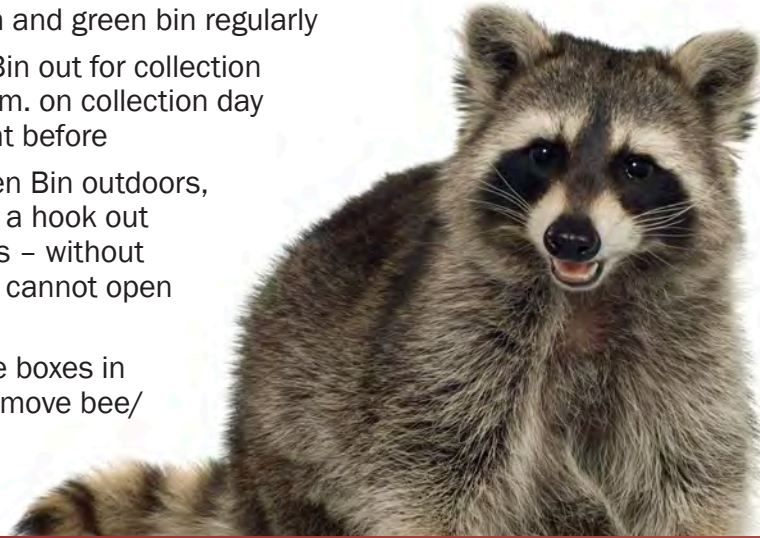










TIPS TO REDUCE ODOURS AND PESTS

All garbage can cause odours and may attract pests. There are many ways to reduce the potential for odour and pests. You can:

- Keep your green bin tightly closed at all times
- Wrap organics in layers of newspaper
- Try keeping materials in a sealed container in the refrigerator or freezer until collection day
- Use certified compostable bags & tie tightly when full
- Wash your mini bin and green bin regularly
- Place your Green Bin out for collection every week at 7 a.m. on collection day instead of the night before
- If storing your Green Bin outdoors, try hanging it from a hook out of reach of animals – without leverage raccoons cannot open the latch
- Keep rural garbage boxes in good repair and remove bee/hornet nests
