

TAXATION INFORMATION

- ◆ Payments must be received by the Due Date...Penalty of 1¼% of any unpaid amount will be added on the first day after the “Due Date” and on the first day of each month thereafter until paid. Sufficient time should be allowed for mailed payments to reach the Municipal Office on or before the “Due Date”. Canada Post is not an agent for the municipality; therefore, penalty will not be waived if the payment is not delivered on time.
- ◆ Post-dated cheques are encouraged.
- ◆ Tax bills that are to be paid by the mortgage company should be sent to the mortgage company, immediately, along with a request for them to provide the Municipality with pertinent billing information, in writing.
- ◆ **Please TAKE NOTICE...The onus lies with the property owner to ensure that their taxes are paid and that the Municipality is properly notified in writing of any address changes, mortgage company information, and/or failure to receive a Tax Notice.**

2009 DOG TAGS

Every dog must have a new dog tag each year. Dog tags may be purchased through the mail, in person at our office, or at the following locations:

Lisle Food Mart—8386 Main Street Lisle

Everett Variety—8097 Main Street Everett

Pet Value—161 Yonge Street Alliston

Stephens Stores—8907 32 Sideroad Glencairn

Dog Tag Forms are also available on our Website, or by using the enclosed form to this bulletin.

The **“Due Date”** for tags and licenses is March 31st. After this date, a late payment charge of \$20.00 will be added to the basic tag price.

The dog tag price is determined by the number of dogs habitually kept on the same property **not** on who claims ownership for the dog. Visiting dogs must have a current dog tag.

The Canine Control Officer may attend your property after March 31st, to collect the dog tag fee or to confirm that a tag has been purchased for each qualifying dog.

The By-law governing dogs, is available for public perusal at the Municipal Office or through our Website.
